

The 2nd Annual VeloTek Grand Prix

Saturday race directions:

From Kansas City, take K-10 west through Lawrence. K-10 turns into 23rd which will "T" out by the Clinton State Park. Turn right then take second left into park. Follow signs to Campground #1. Don't forget your \$6.50 park gate fee or buy an annual park pass.

Sunday race directions:

US Highway 24 east from Topeka or west from Lawrence. Look for the large "Thompsonville-Rd" Sign on US-24 Highway. Go north on Thompsonville road and follow race signs to the Thompsonville Hill just west of the Perry Lake Dam.

Join race promoter and USA Cycling Elite Licensed coach Jim Whittaker for his favorite athletic challenge, a time based stage race. Race multiple stages in two days to test your cycling ability. Don't underestimate the short time trial, and if you think Kansas is flat then you'll be surprised on Sunday!

Race entries must be received by Thursday April 28th to avoid surcharges. **Use Active.com!**

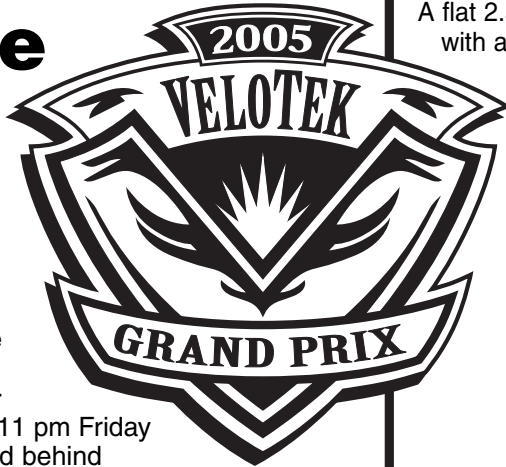
Juniors must register and USCF waiver must be received by Thursday to avoid surcharge.

PROLOGUE TIME TRIAL & CRIT - Saturday, April 30th

A flat 2.5 KM twisty prologue at Clinton Lake, just west of Lawrence Kansas in the morning with a 9 am start time. That afternoon at Clinton Lake – a fun crit on a 1.1 mile loop with time bonus of 7,5,2 seconds for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each crit category.

ROAD RACE - Sunday, May 1st

A challenging 29 mile loop around Lake Perry. 9 am start for Cat.3's. Subsequent groups leave at three minute intervals. (Cat. 3/4/5 40+ next, then Cat. 4, and so on) Juniors 10-12 will do a 7 mile race. Time bonus of 10,7,5 seconds for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category.
