

# KANSAS STATE TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Sunday June 5th - Walnut, KS

First rider starts at 12 noon. Refer to start table for distance and category details. Start times will be assigned on a first come first served basis within each distance. Start times will be posted at 11AM day of race. There will be a spaghetti feed after the race for a few bucks.

**REGISTRATION:**

Pre-register by mailing standard release and check to:

Add \$5 late fee if postmarked after May 31st  
Race day reg. opens @ 9AM & closes @ 11AM at the Post Office on the west side of Main St. Race day entries add \$5 late fee

All USCF rules apply, CPSC approved helmets required. Promoter reserves the right to change distance/time or what ever he needs to keep things running smoothly.

**DIRECTIONS:**

If you will arrive after noon please follow these directions to avoid driving on the course.  
Registration is at the US Post Office 119 S. Main St Walnut, KS 66780.  
**From Wichita:** Hwy 54 east to Hwy 59 south to Hwy 57 east, go 11 miles to 20th St (paved road). Go north on 20th St 6.5 miles (follow pavement through curves) to registration.  
**From KC:** Hwy 69 south to Hwy 57 west, go 21 miles to 20th St (paved road). Go north on 20th St 6.5 miles (follow pavement through curves) to registration.  
**All others:** Get to Hwy 57 between Girard and St. Paul, KS and take 20th St (paved road) north 6.5 miles to Walnut. 20th St is 13 miles west of Girard and 5 miles east of St. Paul.

**COURSE:**

10 & 20K are straight east/west out and back.  
40K is an "L" shaped course, all one road with a sweeping bend. Pavement is smooth and traffic will be very low. Course is almost flat with some "hills" of 200-300 meters long with sections of 2-3%. Start in Walnut, KS on Hwy 146 east.  
10K and 20K races go east to turnaround and return to Walnut.  
40K follows bend in road turning south onto Hwy 3 passing through Brazilton before reaching turnaround 100 meters north of Hwy 57 and returning to Walnut.

Medals awarded to the top three Kansas riders (w/annual license) in each class. One day licensees may race but can not medal. All riders are eligible for cash prizes in their category.
