## Wheat Grass Prologue

March 17th- 2.5 KM.

Prologue preregistration is \$7.00. Race day registration is \$14.00 (pre-register at any prior Spring Fling or via US Mail.)

Prologue TT race order same as crit. Starting at 9:15 am. Registration opens at 8:00 am. and closes at 9 am.

## Spring Fling Scoring

### Daily points race scoring:

Points Sprints 4,3,2,1

Last lap Sprint 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

Your actually race day finish is transferred to the series points total. 1st - 11 points 2nd - 10, 3rd - 9, 4th - 8, 5th - 7, 6th - 6, 7th - 5, 8th - 4, 9th - 3, 10th - 2. 1 point for starting race.

**Prologue** (March 17th) is added to series points total.

Points 8,7,6,5,4,3,2, 1 point for racing.

Series points receive +1 Bonus on March 24th, and +2 on March 31st race. Your series placing will be a total of 6 of your 7 highest races. (series has "one drop")

Registration opens at 10:00 am and closes 15 minutes prior to each race. All USCF Rules apply. One day licenses, \$10. Race will be held rain or shine. Category 1/2 women may race the Men's 1/2/3 or 3/4 race. Kansas State Park Vehicle pass required or one-day \$3.75 at park gate. (Park fee reduced for 2007!) Prize list for series only. Series prizes are a combination of Sponsors Bike Shop Gift certificates, & other quality merchandise items.

Entry fee is \$23 per race day to race all eligible crit categories. Race two or more times if qualified on one entry fee. \$95 for crit series and prologue time trial. Youth and juniors race free in junior class only. Entry fee includes \$2 USA Cycling Insurance fee, \$1 KCA surcharge, and \$1 Clinton Lake Handicap Fund donation. Prologue on March 17th \$7.00 "pre-registered" or "\$14.00 day off race. REGISTER EARLY or pay more! Entry fee's are non-refundable. USCF Rules limit Cat 5 race field to 50 riders! First come first serve if 50 or more show up. Promoter retains the right to modify race lengths.

Course: Flat, smooth, fast and fun with weekly changes. Laps are .65 to 1.0 miles and don't miss the Chicanes.

Directions from KC, take K-10 West through Lawrence. K-10 turns into 23rd st which will "T" out by the park. Turn right then take your second left into the park. Follow signs to Campground #1. Don't forget your \$3.75 park gate fee or buy annual park pass.

Race winners or their representative must be present at awards ceremony to collect prizes. Riders not able to attend ceremony may pick up prizes with 14 days at the Revolution Racing office. After that time race winnings will be recycled.
