The Big Ring Dirt Road Series is about to roll out for 2007! Races will be held in the Wichita, Kansas area. Cyclocross bikes are recommended but not required. All racers must have a current USCF license or purchase a one day permit on race day. Races will be held on dirt/gravel country roads. Surfaces may include but are not limited to: dirt, rocks, mud, gravel, dust, ice, snow, sand, and even pavement. Restrooms or changing areas are not provided, so take care of business before you arrive! The surfaces are varied and the terrain will make each race very challenging. The roads are open to traffic and wildlife. Each rider is expected to obey ALL traffic laws and laws of nature.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per stage

Juniors: \$3.00 per stage (USCF Insurance & KCA Surcharge)



Race Rules and Information

- All 2007 USCF Rules apply.
- Events will be held rain or shine.
- Helmets must be worn at all times on the bike.
- Valid and current USCF license required or one day license (\$10.00 per day) must be presented at registration.
- Promoter reserves the right to adjust start time, mileage, courses, cancel/combine events.
- In case of a tie the series winner will be determined by the finish order of the final race.
- Fees include \$2.00 for USCF Insurance /\$1.00 for KCA Surcharge.

#1 November 4, 2007

“Musher’s Mayhem” (5 laps) (Juniors 3 laps)

Indianola Road and US-54 Highway (3 miles east of Andover Road on US-54) Park at West Butler County Office parking lot (do not park at Airport Parking Lots). This course is a 6 mile loop with varying terrain.

#2 November 18, 2007

“Towanda” (6 laps) (Juniors 3 laps)

Towanda is 16 miles east of Wichita on 254 Highway or 7 miles west of El Dorado on 254 Highway. Park at Circle High School. (East edge of town) This 5 mile loop has several tough hills and a low water bridge crossing to negotiate.

Series Scoring

Each week points will be awarded to all riders that finish in each race. Points will be awarded as follows: 1-25, 2-22, 3-19, 4-17, 5-15, 6-13, 7-11, 8-9, 9-7, 10-5, remaining finishers will receive 3 points each. The rider with the highest point total at the end of the series will be declared the Big Ring Dirt Road Series Champion. The series champion in the "A" race will have their name engraved on the Big Ring Dirt Road Series trophy displayed in the Bicycle X-Change Shop at 908 West Douglas.
