Place/Participation Points for each race:

14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3. 2 for finishing, 1 DNF.

You must race a minimum of two(2) calendar dates to qualify for the awards.

Bonus Points: Categories, M,1,2,3,4 & W,1,2,3 ONLY

Bonus Points: 1st Lap Only: 4, 2, 1, Mountain Goat Points(Overall will receive a cup)

Rules: All USA Cycling Rules apply. Helmets must be worn by all participants while riding at any time during this event. **Yellow Line Rule is in effect, USCF Official Monitored and strictly enforced:** Roads will be open to traffic. Parking, see participant map on reverse. Promoter reserves right to combine classes or shorten races. **Four(4) or less riders can stop a category. Licenses:** All riders must have a current USA Cycling license. One-day license and annual license applications will be available. One day license cost is \$10.00. **Beginner racers can only race beginners for the series. No exceptions. Note Beginners racers are not scored.** **Weather:** Races will be held rain or shine. In the event of ice or snow, weather cancellations, call 913.680.9817 the morning of the race, listen to voice message for race course weather conditions. **PRE REGISTRATION WILL NOT be online for two reasons, one is the extra cost to either the rider or the promoter and I have encountered many problems with online registration groups so I have decided to go with the registration process as stated in the next paragraph.**

USPS. Pre Registration can be accomplished by mailing a completed Athletic Release Form for each Series date entered. Be sure to note on each form the races wishing to enter. Mail must arrive by March 4, 2010.

Sample Entry for Pre Registration:
Series Entry - 3 each, ONE for March 7, ONE for 14th, and ONE for 21st. Cost \$60.00. Race Entered noted on each one of the sheets. IF you wish to add a race to each date, then enter the race for that date. So if you entered 2 races per calendar date for the entire series it would be \$90.00 total.

Registration: Race Day registration begins at 9:00AM and closes 30 minutes before each race start time.

Cost(s):

Pre - Registration: \$60(\$45Jrs) for series; 1 race per calendar-date.

Day of Race Registration: \$90(\$75Jrs) for series; 1 race per date.

Additional race: \$10 per race per race date.

Individual Race: \$30 per race date (first race of the date)

B Categories: \$12 entire series(B registrants must remain B racers for the entire series.

All Fees include: \$3 for USCF Insurance and \$1 for KCA Surcharge. Trophy, or Medal will be mailed to recipient as they are personalized. It is important that the personal information is CORRECT and LEGIBLE

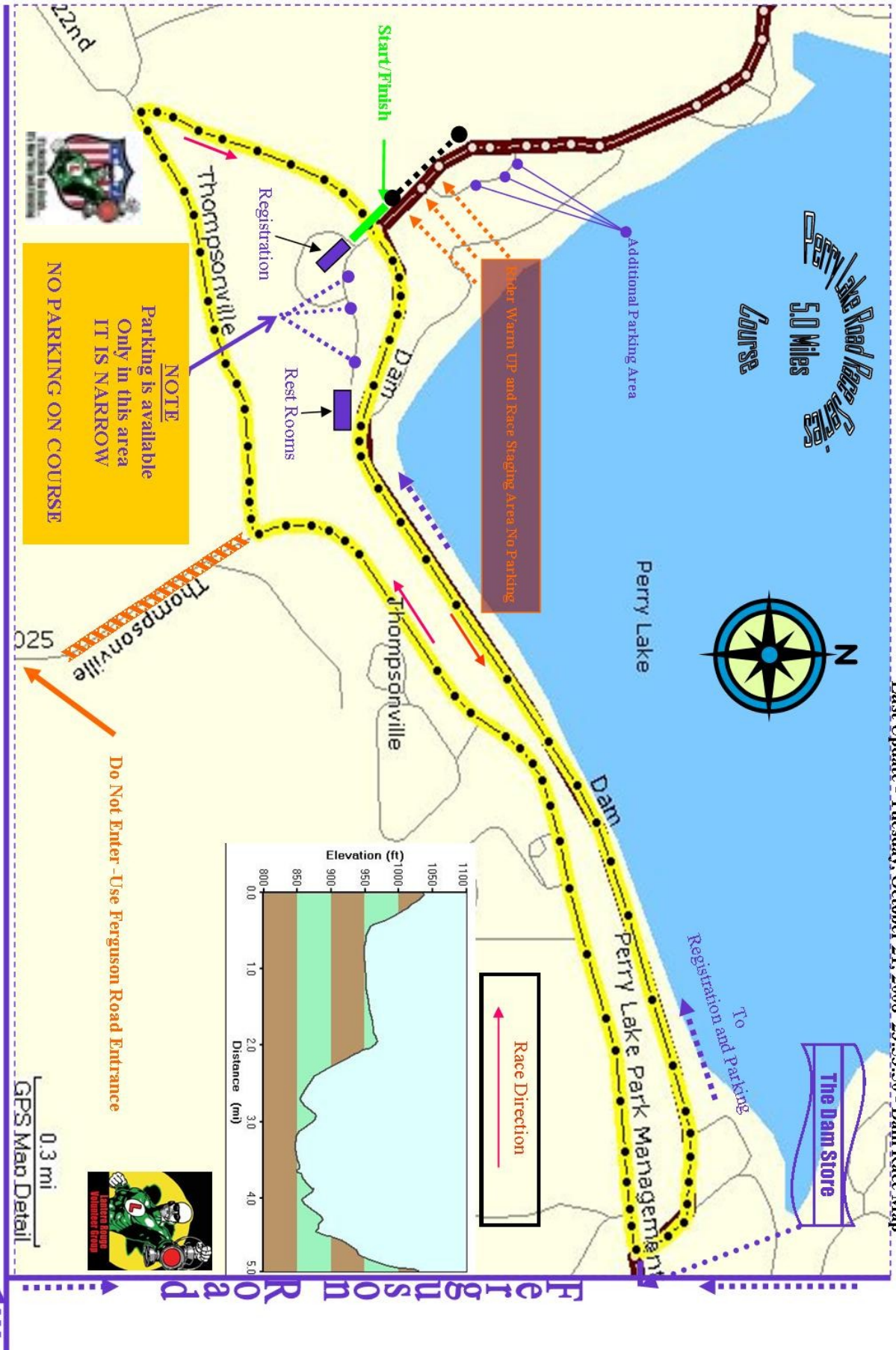

Please use Ferguson Road Entrance so mud is not on the course, and warm-up riders will not be interfered with.

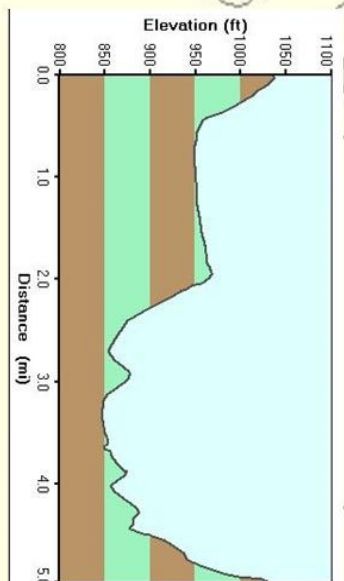
