**Registration:** Opens onsite only at 10:00 am and closes 15 minutes prior to each race. All riders may race two or more times as qualified by category on one entry fee, e.g. Cat 3/4 women may additionally race the Men's 3/4 or 4 race. USA Cycling rules limit the Cat 5 race fields to 50 riders and entry will be first come first served. Pre-Registration for the March 13 Prologue is available Feb 27 and March 6 and then as Day of Registration on March 13 closing at 8:15 am.

**Entry Fee:** \$24 per race day / \$115 (a \$37 savings) for the entire series including the prologue time trial. Youth and juniors (in junior class only) race FREE. Entry fee includes a \$3 USA Cycling Insurance fee, \$1 KCA fee, and \$1 Clinton Lake Handicap Fund donation. Entry for the Prologue only on March 14th is \$8 if pre-registered from an earlier event or \$15 the day of the race. Entry fees are non-refundable.

**Rules & Scoring:** All USA Cycling (USAC) Rules apply. USAC approved helmets must be worn at all times. The Spring Fling is a points based series of six Criteriums and one prologue time trial. 3/4 Men Crits 60min to start progressing to 70 by the end of the series. Scoring details for all races follow on page two of this flyer.

**Weather:** Races will be held rain or shine. Should a cancellation be required by ice or snow, information as such will be posted at www.revolution-racing.com

**Licenses:** All riders must present a valid and current USA Cycling (www.usacycling.org) license in order to compete. Onsite one day licenses are \$10.

**Prizes:** The prize list is for the overall series winners only based on highest cumulated scoring from all events combined. Series prizes are a combination of sponsors gift certificates and other merchandise. Additional daily prizes may also be made available. Race winners or their representatives must be present at the awards ceremony on April 3 to collect prizes. Additionally, prizes may be picked up within 14 days by contacting Revolution Racing, otherwise prizes will be forfeit.

**Course:** Flat, smooth, fast and fun with weekly changes. Laps are 0.65 to 1.0 miles. Location and course details follow on page two of this flyer. Further course details and a copy of this flyer are available at at www.revolution-racing.com

# 2010 Spring Fling Criterium Series - Clinton Lake, Lawrence Kansas

## Scoring

The Spring Fling is a points based series of seven races (six Criteriums and one prologue time trial) with the series prize list being awarded based on the ranking of total **Series Points** accumulated per racer at the conclusion of all races. The series provides for one "dropped" race, only taking a riders top six of seven daily finishes towards the final series placings.

Series Points points are awarded for placing daily on Feb 27, Mar 6, 13 & 20 as follows with bonuses for the Mar 27 and Apr 3 races:

Entry to the park is via N 1415th Rd located just North of the intersection of W Clinton Parkway and K-10 on E 900th Rd. Access to the race requires a one day park entry fee of up to \$4.20 per vehicle or an annual park pass. 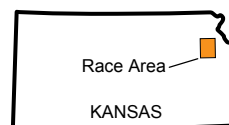
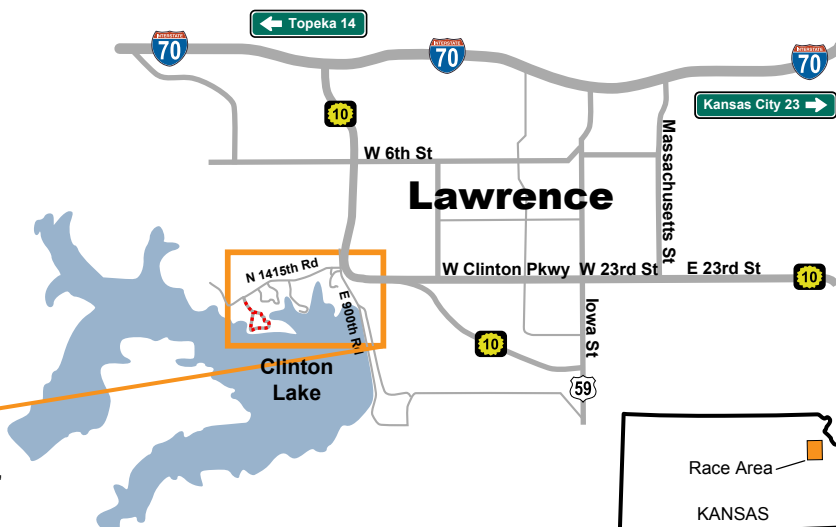
