GROOMING AND POOPING CHOICES

The Holiday Inn offers large, grassy dog walk areas and grassy edging around the walkways. To make the best use of all grass, private x-pens will be restricted. **NO private x-pens will be allowed on grass!** You will need to bring a mat for under the x-pen or tarp and chips. There is plenty of room to bicycle or run your dog. You will be responsible for cleaning up after your own dog. Bags and trash receptacles will be located all over the grounds.

Indoor grooming with limited electricity will be adjacent to the show ring. No private x-pens in grooming room. The **Show site will be available for exhibitors Monday, October 25, 2010 in the afternoon.** You may be asked to share electricity. No X-pens allowed in the public grooming area. Crating and grooming will be allowed in designated areas only. You may be asked to stack your crates. No saving of grooming space and no mats allowed in the grooming area. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of grooming tables per handler. Cleanup of the grooming area will be the owner's responsibility, and will be policed daily. Dogs may be left over-night in the grooming area **AT THE OWNER'S RISK.**

All passageways must be kept open; grooming and crates are not allowed in walkways. Aisles will be marked for easy access. Aisles, grooming and crating areas will be designated.

The only exception will be when adequate information is included with the ad to verify that the advertised Siberian is too young for OFA (two years) and/or CERF/SHOR (one year). When this occurs, it will be so stated.

Electronic submission in one of the formats specified below is preferred, however, you may submit your ad by sending your requested layout on a piece of paper along with actual photograph(s), and any other component parts (such as logos, etc.) that will be needed to create your ad. **There is an additional \$10 charge if the ad is not submitted print ready.**

If submitting your ad electronically, follow the guidelines below:
