Every dog completing an Agility Title at the Trial will receive a 15" rosette offered by Theresa Przybylski in memory of U-ACH, U-CD Sasha in the Snow CDX, OA, CGC, Can CD, Bmd CD

Agility HIT to be awarded from the Standard Class including Regular and Preferred to the Highest Scoring Siberian Husky. In case of a tie in score, then seconds under course time will be weighted as follows in determining HIT. Using the following calculations, HIT would go to the Siberian Husky with the highest number:

- Novice Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 1
 - Open Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2
 - Excellent Preferred Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3
 - Novice Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2 with 5 points added
 - Open Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3 with 5 points added
 - Excellent Standard: Seconds under course time multiplied by 4 with 5 points added
- All ribbons and prizes to be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed. A qualifying score is required for all prizes and awards.

- Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions
 - Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes **MUST** jump in their measured division (they are not allowed to jump higher as Regular Class dogs are).
- SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS**
- **NEW ENTRY FORM AS OF JANUARY 2010:** The new entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**
 - All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial upon request. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of Record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured regardless of the jump height entered. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so may result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- All dogs **MUST** be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.
- In accordance with AKC Rules applying to Dog Shows, no dogs under the age of six (6) months are allowed on the show site.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial Site. In such case, no refund will be made of any fees paid.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone witnessed not cleaning up after their dogs will be requested to leave and no refund will be made of any fees paid.
- The Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Electronic timers will be used.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to Siberian Huskies 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP or PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WALK-THROUGHS

- **All obstacles and equipment used in this trial meet the specifications stated in the current American Kennel Club's Requirements for Agility Trials.**
- Handlers in all classes may walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. Each walkthrough will be restricted to handlers with an entry in that class/jump height. At the discretion of the judge a separate walk-through may be held for a division within a class due to the size of the class.
- A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

For submitting paper entries, please note the following:

- For limited trials, entries are limited to a maximum of ten (10) dogs per envelope. Envelopes containing more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must:
 - Include postage or be metered.
 - Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL.
- Hand deliveries will be permitted **after** the first 24 hours the trial is open.
- A fee of \$25 will be charged for all returned checks.

ENTRY FORMS

To be acceptable, an entry must:

- Be submitted with required entry fee
- Entries must be on an Official American Kennel Club entry form including agreement on reverse
- Be **signed** by the owner or his duly authorized agent.
- Be completed in full, accurate, and reflective of the dog entered.
- Include all of the following information:
 - Name of show/trial giving club and Date of show/trial
 - Breed, Variety (if any), Sex
 - Name of class(es) entered, Jump Height, Height at Withers
 - Full/registered Name of dog
 - Name and Address of owner(s)/co-owner(s)
 - AKC # (registration, litter, ILP, ID) or Foreign reg # & country or identification number issued by AKC
 - Breeder, Sire & DAM are required (except for ILP/PAL dogs)**
- **Express mail entries must be marked "no signature required" which allows them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address.**
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified.)

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry that is missing any AKC-required information above.
- Entries not on official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current agreement and rules on the reverse side or attached to the entry form.
- Entries that are illegible or incomplete (see above).
- Entries received with insufficient fees will be returned.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, email, telephone, fax, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. The Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc. is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

CONFIRMATIONS

- If you have provided a valid, unblocked e-mail address on your entry, you will receive an initial confirmation after your entry has been processed. Please review this confirmation for input errors. If you do not receive your initial confirmation within a reasonable time frame after sending in your entry, please call or e-mail the trial secretary to confirm receipt of your entry.
- Final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the email address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date.
- Initial and final confirmations will be sent via US mail only if an exhibitor does not provide an email address.
- If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within five days of the show, please call the Trial Secretary.

MOVE-UPS

- **Move-Ups will be allowed.**
 - The following information must be provided in writing (via e-mail or US mail) to the agility trial secretary: owner's name, dog's call name, title completed and date, and new class.
 - All move-ups must be received no later than **6 pm on Monday, October 25, 2010**
 - No move-up is official until you have received a written or email acknowledgement.

WITHDRAWALS

- **Withdrawals are allowed before the trial closes.** All withdrawal requests must be made in writing or by email and must include the dog's registered & call names, breed, AKC reg. #, class entered, owner's name and date. **No withdrawal is official until you have a written or email acknowledgement.**
- Checks for withdrawn entries will be shredded unless the exhibitor makes a specific request for the check to be returned.
- Bitches "in season" will not be allowed to compete in the trial. A refund of all but \$10.00 for bitches in season upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian to the agility trial secretary no later than 1 hour before the trial.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
